RESOLUTION #4B-20-0501

**Requesting Elimination of Two Parking Spaces on 3rd Street, NE
Adopted May 26, 2020**

Advisory Neighborhood Commission 4B takes note of the following:

- A traffic study conducted by Gorove & Slade finds the sightlines at the driveway at Walmart (310 Riggs Road, NE) are poor for exiting vehicles due to topography and on-street parking. Vehicles were observed encroaching onto the sidewalk in order to improve visibility. This report recommends that one (1) or two (2) on-street parking spaces up- and downstream of the Walmart driveway be removed to improve the sightlines.
- In addition to eliminating the spaces, installation of flex posts would prevent illegal parking in the future.
- The proposed parking space removal will improve traffic safety and circulation in the vicinity of the Walmart.

RESOLVED:

That Advisory Neighborhood Commission 4B supports and requests the removal of two (2) parking spaces and the installation of flex posts to the left of the Walmart exit on 3rd Street, NE.

FURTHER RESOLVED:

That Commissioner Alison Brooks, ANC 4B08, is hereby authorized to serve as the Commission's representative in all matters relating to this Resolution.

FURTHER RESOLVED:

That, in the event the designated representative Commissioner cannot carry out their representative duties for any reason, the Commission authorizes the Chair to designate another Commissioner to represent the Commission in all matter relating to this Resolution.

FURTHER RESOLVED:

That, consistent with DC Code § 1-309, only actions of the full Commission voting in a properly noticed public meeting have standing and carry great weight. The actions, positions, and opinions of individual commissioners, insofar as they may be contradictory to or otherwise inconsistent with the expressed position of the full Commission in a properly adopted resolution or letter, have no standing and cannot be considered as in any way associated with the Commission.
