### **RESOLUTION #4B-20-1003**

**Requesting Speed Humps on Longfellow Street, NW**

**Adopted October 26, 2020**

Advisory Neighborhood Commission 4B takes note of the following:

- Residents request speed humps on 6<sup>th</sup> Street, NE, between Eastern Avenue, NE, and Oneida Street, NE to reduce vehicular speeding.
- Speeding on 6<sup>th</sup> Street, NE, has been an issue for quite a while and residents have requested the District Department of Transportation address the issue.
- Based on feedback from the community, the speeding is becoming a greater and greater quality of life issue.

#### **RESOLVED:**

That Advisory Neighborhood Commission 4B supports the urgent request for speed humps on 6<sup>th</sup> Street, NE.

#### **FURTHER RESOLVED:**

That Commissioner Alison Brooks, ANC 4B08, is hereby authorized to serve as the Commission's representative in all matters relating to this Resolution.

#### **FURTHER RESOLVED:**

That, in the event the designated representative Commissioner cannot carry out their representative duties for any reason, the Commission authorizes the Chair to designate another Commissioner to represent the Commission in all matter relating to this Resolution.
