



## **Government of the District of Columbia Advisory Neighborhood Commission 4B**

### **[DRAFT] RESOLUTION #4B-21-0403**

**Requesting Removal of One Storage Container and Relocation of Another  
Storage Container at Riggs LaSalle Recreation Center**

**Approved April 26, 2021**

Advisory Neighborhood Commission 4B takes note of the following:

- In July 2020, District Department of Parks and Recreation Project Manager Peter Nohrden and Site Director Shirlita Settles agreed that three (3) unused storage containers at Riggs LaSalle Recreation Center, 501 Riggs Road, NE, would be relocated. It was agreed that two storage containers would be removed from the field in their entirety (one has been removed) and that one container would be relocated to a location that would not obstruct future use of the field.
- The request for the removal of the containers stems from rodents burrowing underneath the containers and long-standing requests from residents who hope to reduce the rodent infestation.
- The removal of the containers would aid in decreasing rodent infestation, improve the overall public safety and use of the field, as well as allow for future development of the green space along the 500 block Nicholson Street, NE, and the hill area along the 400 block of Madison Street, NE, to perhaps include a community garden space, gazebo, sporting zone area, zip-line, etc.

#### **RESOLVED:**

- That Advisory Neighborhood Commission 4B supports the removal of the agreed upon storage container and relocation of the second container at Riggs LaSalle Recreation Center.

#### **FURTHER RESOLVED:**

That the Commission designates Commissioner LaRoya Huff, ANC 4B09, represent the Commission in all matters relating to this Resolution.

**FURTHER RESOLVED:**

That, in the event the designated representative Commissioner cannot carry out their representative duties for any reason, the Commission authorizes the Chair to designate another Commissioner to represent the Commission in all matter relating to this Resolution.

**FURTHER RESOLVED:**

That, consistent with DC Code § 1-309, only actions of the full Commission voting in a properly noticed public meeting have standing and carry great weight. The actions, positions, and opinions of individual commissioners, insofar as they may be contradictory to or otherwise inconsistent with the expressed position of the full Commission in a properly adopted resolution or letter, have no standing and cannot be considered as in any way associated with the Commission.
