### **RESOLUTION #4B-21-0401**

#### **Supporting the Proposal to Install a FitLot at Lamond Recreation Center Adopted April 26, 2021**

Advisory Neighborhood Commission 4B (Commission) takes note of the following:

- AARP is offering to donate and install a “FitLot,” which is an outdoor fitness space featuring a combination of exercise equipment, at Lamond Recreation Center.
- The donation would also include funding to support three years of instructor-led, no-cost fitness classes for all ages and abilities.
- The suggested location for the FitLot is the paved handball court area on the north side of the Lamond Recreation Center.
- Representatives from AARP presented the FitLot proposal before ANC 4B on March 22, 2021 and then at a community meeting on April 7, 2021. The proposal was well received and the community expressed no major concerns or objections.
- The handball court area at Lamond Recreation Center has long been overlooked and underutilized, and the community is interested in options to activate this space.

#### **RESOLVED:**

- That Advisory Neighborhood Commission 4B supports installation of the proposed FitLot at Lamond Recreation Center; and
- That the Commission requests that the Department of Parks and Recreation works with the community to develop plans to appropriately landscape or otherwise utilize any additional space inside of the handball court.

#### **FURTHER RESOLVED:**

That the Commission designates Commissioner Geoff Bromaghim, ANC 4B07, to represent the Commission in all matters relating to this Resolution.

**FURTHER RESOLVED:**

That, in the event the designated representative Commissioners cannot carry out their representative duties for any reason, the Commission authorizes the Chair to designate another Commissioner to represent the Commission in all matter relating to this Resolution.

**FURTHER RESOLVED:**

That, consistent with DC Code § 1-309, only actions of the full Commission voting in a properly noticed public meeting have standing and carry great weight. The actions, positions, and opinions of individual commissioners, insofar as they may be contradictory to or otherwise inconsistent with the expressed position of the full Commission in a properly adopted resolution or letter, have no standing and cannot be considered as in any way associated with the Commission.
