RESOLUTION #4B-21-0502

**Requesting Installation of Speed Humps on the Unit Block of Underwood
Place, NW**

Adopted May 24, 2021

Advisory Neighborhood Commission 4B (ANC 4B or the Commission) takes note of the following:

- Commissioner Geoff Bromaghim, ANC 4B07, has received concerns from constituents regarding speeding and reckless driving along the unit block of Underwood Place, NW.
- Commissioner Geoff Bromaghim, ANC 4B07, has received requests from neighbors on the unit block of Underwood Place, NW for assistance in encouraging the District Department of Transportation to install speed humps.
- Households on the unit block of Underwood Place, NW were petitioned in April 2021, and the vast majority indicated their support for the installation of speed humps.

RESOLVED:

That Advisory Neighborhood Commission 4B recognizes community support for speed humps on the unit block of Underwood Place, NW, and calls on the District Department of Transportation to promptly install speed humps along this block.

FURTHER RESOLVED:

That the Commission designates Commissioner Geoff Bromaghim, ANC 4B07, to represent the Commission in all matters relating to this resolution.

FURTHER RESOLVED:

That, in the event the designated representative Commissioner cannot carry out his representative duties for any reason, the Commission authorizes the

Chair to designate another Commissioner to represent the Commission in all matters relating to this resolution.

FURTHER RESOLVED:

That, consistent with DC Code § 1-309, only actions of the full Commission voting in a properly noticed public meeting have standing and carry great weight. The actions, positions and opinions of individual commissioners, insofar as they may be contradictory to or otherwise inconsistent with the expressed position of the full Commission in a properly adopted resolution or letter, have no standing and cannot be considered as in any way associated with the Commission.
