**Supporting Grant Award for Whittier Elementary School Parent Teacher Organization
Adopted October 24, 2022**

Advisory Neighborhood Commission 4B takes note of the following:

- The Commission has the authority to provide grants to community organizations that are public in nature and for projects that benefit people who live and work within Advisory Neighborhood Commission 4B's boundaries.
- The Parent Teacher Organization at Whittier Elementary School serves as a collaborative voice for parents, teachers, families, and the community to push the Whittier mission into action. The Organization works hard to reflect the diverse views of parents and families at the school. The Organization has goals to build strong relationships with families, partner around academics, and engage families in meaningful decisionmaking.
- Whittier Elementary School's Parent Teacher Organization seeks to purchase STEMscopes kits (a comprehensive curriculum with hands-on kits) for students in Kindergarten through 5th grade.

RESOLVED:

- That Advisory Neighborhood Commission 4B grants Whittier Elementary School's Parent Teacher Organization \$3,000 to support community activities outlined in the submitted application.
- That Advisory Neighborhood Commission 4B requires Whittier Elementary School's Parent Teacher Organization to provide all required documentation outlined in the application package.

FURTHER RESOLVED:

That the Commission designates Commissioner Alison Brooks, Chair, to represent the Commission in all matters relating to this Resolution.

FURTHER RESOLVED:

That, in the event the designated representative Commissioner cannot carry out their representative duties for any reason, the Commission authorizes the Chair to designate another Commissioner to represent the Commission in all matters relating to this Resolution.

FURTHER RESOLVED:

That, consistent with DC Code § 1-309, only actions of the full Commission voting in a properly noticed public meeting have standing and carry great weight. The actions, positions, and opinions of individual commissioners, insofar as they may be contradictory to or otherwise inconsistent with the expressed position of the full Commission in a properly adopted resolution or letter, have no standing and cannot be considered as in any way associated with the Commission.
