RESOLUTION #4B-26-XXXX

Requesting Installation of Public Litter Cans in the 600–700 Blocks of Missouri Avenue NW

Adopted January 26, 2026

Advisory Neighborhood Commission 4B (Commission) takes note of the following:

- Advisory Neighborhood Commission (ANC) 4B06 has received constituent concerns regarding litter accumulation along the 600–700 blocks of Missouri Avenue NW.
- This corridor experiences consistent pedestrian traffic, including residents, visitors, and transit riders, contributing to ongoing litter issues without a designated receptacle.
- The installation of public litter cans will support neighborhood cleanliness and advance ANC 4B06's priorities for infrastructure and beautification;
- The Containing Litter and Ensuring Adequate Neighborhood (CLEAN) Collections Amendment Act of 2024 (D.C. Law 25-297) requires the District Department of Public Works (DPW) to install and maintain public litter containers in residential areas, amending the Sustainable Solid Waste Management Amendment Act of 2014 (D.C. Law 20-154; D.C. Official Code § 8-1031.01 et seq.).
- Title 21 of the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations (DCMR), Chapters 7 and 8, provides DPW with authority to regulate solid waste, sanitation, and recycling, including the placement, servicing, and enforcement of public litter cans.

RESOLVED:

- ANC 4B (the Commission) formally requests that DPW install public litter cans in the 600–700 blocks of Missouri Avenue NW in accordance with D.C. Law 25-297 and Title 21 DCMR.

- The Commission urges DPW to monitor the effectiveness of the installation and ensure timely servicing of the litter cans to maintain cleanliness and accessibility.

FURTHER RESOLVED:

That the Commission designates Commissioner Tiffani Nichole Johnson, Vice-Chair of ANC 4B, to represent the Commission in all matters relating to this Resolution.

FURTHER RESOLVED:

That, in the event the designated representative Commissioner cannot carry out their representative duties for any reason, the Commission authorizes the Chair to designate another Commissioner to represent the Commission in all matters relating to this Resolution.

FURTHER RESOLVED:

That, consistent with DC Code § 1-309, only actions of the full Commission voting in a properly noticed public meeting have standing and carry great weight. The actions, positions, and opinions of individual commissioners, insofar as they may be contradictory or otherwise inconsistent with the expressed position of the full Commission in a properly adopted resolution or letter, have no standing and cannot be considered in any way associated with the Commission.
