**Grant Award for Friends of Riggs-LaSalle Recreation Center – Riggs Park  
Day**

**Adopted April 27, 2026**

Advisory Neighborhood Commission (ANC) 4B (Commission) takes note of the following:

**WHEREAS**, The Commission has the authority to provide grants to community organizations that are public in nature and for projects that benefit neighbors who live and work within the Commission’s boundaries (DC Code § 1-309.13);

**WHEREAS**, Friends of Riggs-LaSalle Recreation Center (FORLR), a 501(c)3 nonprofit organization, has applied for funding assistance to support Riggs Park Day on Saturday, May 30, 2026, from 12-4pm at Riggs-LaSalle Recreation Center (501B Riggs Rd. NE);

**WHEREAS**, Riggs Park Day welcomes neighbors across ANC 4B to come together for an afternoon of connection and community building including entertainment, food, music, community tabling, and activities for residents of all ages;

**WHEREAS**, The Office of Advisory Neighborhood Commissions (OANC) has reviewed FORLR’s grant application and determined that the proposed grant is a permissible expenditure of ANC monies. See OANC Memo dated March 23, 2026.

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** That the Commission grants FORLR two thousand five hundred twenty-five dollars (\$2,525.00) to support Riggs Park Day, including supply rentals, dance performances, and music education and entertainment, as outlined by the attached grant budget. See FORLR email regarding revised budget dated March 23, 2026.

**FURTHER RESOLVED** That the Commission requires FORLR to provide all required grant reporting, receipts, and related documentation outlined in the application package. Grantee shall submit OANC Form 100A Interim Closeout Report within 60 calendar days of receiving the award and final closeout report no later than July 29, 2026 (60 days after project end).

**FURTHER RESOLVED** That Commissioner Danielle Geong (4B09) is hereby authorized to serve as the Commission's representative in all matters relating to this Resolution. In the event that the Commissioner is unavailable, the Commission authorizes the Chair to serve as the Commission's representative in all matters relating to this Resolution.

**FURTHER RESOLVED** That, consistent with DC Code § 1-309, only actions of the full Commission voting in a properly noticed public meeting have standing and carry great weight. The actions, positions, and opinions of individual commissioners, insofar as they may be contradictory or otherwise inconsistent with the expressed position of the full Commission in a properly adopted resolution or letter, have no standing and cannot be considered in any way associated with the Commission.
